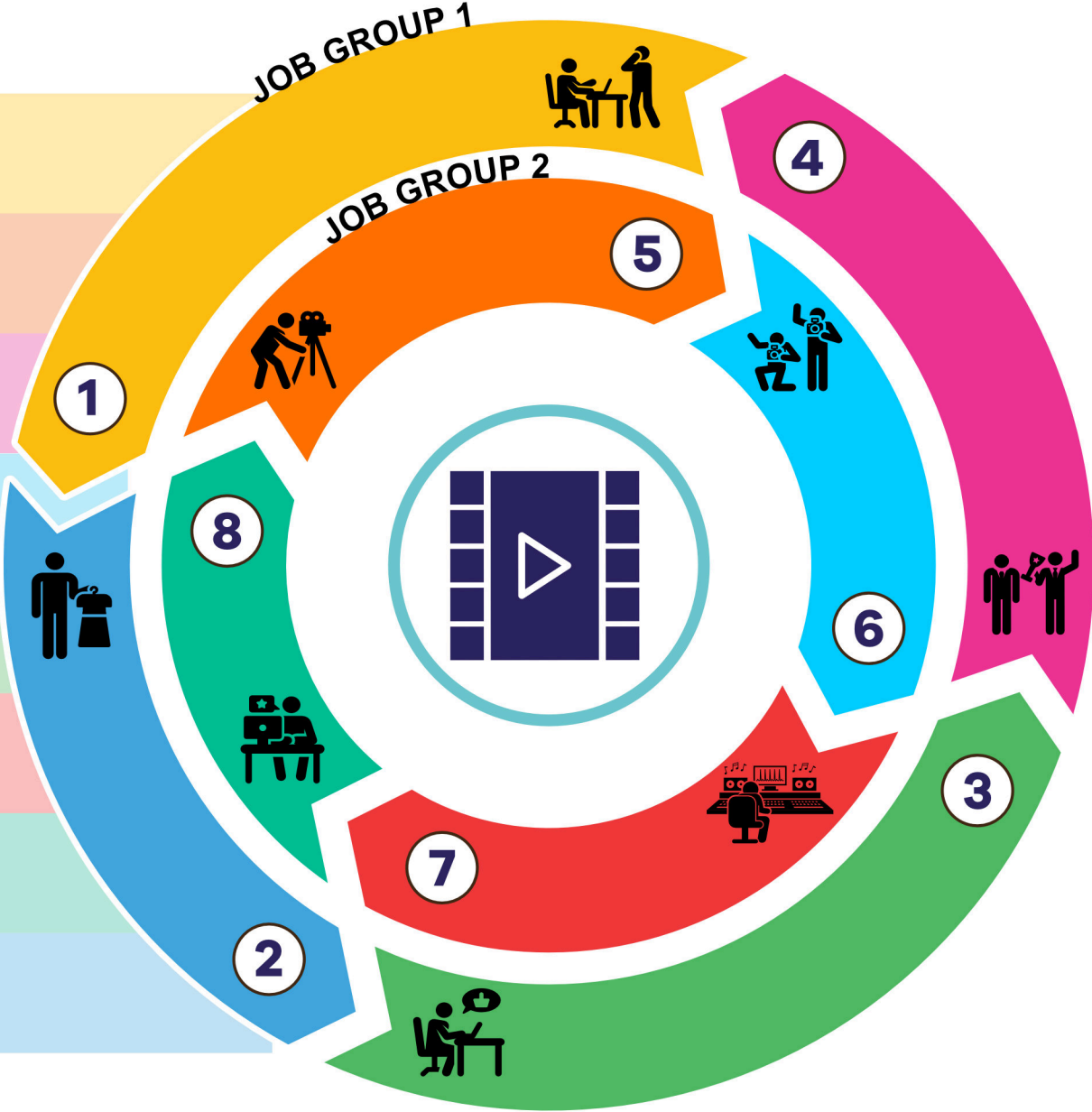

JOB GROUP 1

don't require Level 2 Qualifications / GCSEs but can lead to supported employment, Supported Internships, Inclusive Apprenticeships, supported Enterprise, T-Levels, Traineeships and FE College.



Assistant Editor

They help production teams organise footage, log data, and perform basic editing tasks.

Wardrobe Assistant

They help to make, find and look after clothes and costumes used in theatre, film and TV productions.

They help producers by finding information, people and places for TV or radio programmes.

They operate and record images for film, television, commercials and online.
